

Publication Policy

Scope

The Maternal and Pediatric Precision In Therapeutics (MPRINT) Centers of Excellence (CET) and the Data and Model Knowledge and Research Coordination Center (DMKRCC) work collaboratively under the *Eunice Kennedy Shriver* National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) to conduct and foster therapeutics-focused research in obstetrics, lactation, and pediatrics while enhancing inclusion of people with disabilities.

This policy applies to abstracts, manuscripts, slides, and texts of oral or other presentations, as well as texts of transmission through any electronic media outlet (“Public Presentations”) that are intended to represent MPRINT, are supported by MPRINT, or have used data provided by MPRINT, including those from Support Pool and Opportunity Pool projects.

Authorship

Authorship as appropriate. If a CET or the DMKRCC worked on the project alone, they will maintain authorship. That site will notify the other sites, so they can help promote and track the publication. If two or more sites worked on a project, they will include the others to discuss options. This also includes manuscripts arising from collaborations with organizations and individuals external to the MPRINT Hub.

Funding Source Acknowledgement

The following funding statement must be on every MPRINT publication:

“This work was funded under National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) Maternal and Pediatric Precision In Therapeutics (MPRINT) grant NIH [insert grant # for each authoring site]. The content is solely the responsibility of the authors and does not necessarily represent the official views of the National Institutes of Health.”

For publications arising from affiliated studies, or from data provided through MPRINT-related studies, the acknowledgement should be modified to state the following:

“This work was supported in part by the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) Maternal and Pediatric Precision In Therapeutics (MPRINT) grant NIH [insert grant # for each authoring site]. The content is solely the responsibility of the authors and does not necessarily represent the official views of the National Institutes of Health.”

Acknowledgement

MPRINT publications should acknowledge the MPRINT Steering Committee if the publication results from joint efforts by the CETs and the DMKRCC.

“The authors wish to acknowledge the MPRINT Steering Committee for its support.”

Data Sharing Statement

When needed or requested by a journal/publisher, state the statement below:

To help expand the knowledge base for pediatric and maternal medicine, the MPRINT Hub is pleased to share data from its completed and published studies with interested investigators. For requests, please contact [Corresponding Author of Paper]. In addition, de-identified datasets are also shared in the NICHD Data and Specimen Hub (DASH) repository.

Raw data will be shared within the MPRINT Hub upon completion of analysis, as allowed by other data usage or sharing agreements. Once a journal article is accepted for publication, raw data will be sent to

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1. Complete online required information about the study (such as general information, the investigator(s), policy compliance, and data distribution instructions).
2. Upload completed Institutional Certification into NICHD DASH.
3. Annotate and prepare your study documents and data for submission to NICHD DASH. You will be provided with a downloadable Data Preparation Tool (DPT) to assist you with offline annotation and preparation of your documents and data for submission to NICHD DASH.
4. Upload your study submission to NICHD DASH via the secure and encrypted NICHD DASH system.

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
